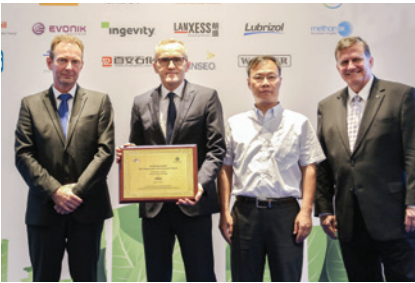
PPG receives perfect score on 2018 Corporate Equality Index
